Our parish has been involved with this Cafod project supporting the people of Sebeya, Ethiopia for the past 5 years. It has now met and exceeded many of the things they hope to do: improving people's income and food supplies, bringing water nearer to homes and farms and helping the community to adapt to extreme climate events such as severe drought. This project will close at the end of the year and our parish will move on to supporting a new project in 2019.

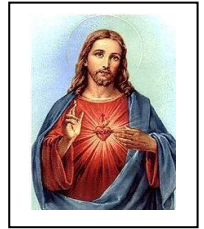
