Following the canonisation of Blessed Oscar Romero later this month, Bishop Peter will celebrate the event with a Mass for the Diocese on Tuesday 20th November, here at Sacred Heart Church. The Mass will be at 7.00pm, followed by refreshments in the hall. Obviously, everyone is welcome!

OBERAMMERGAU 2020

In 1633, during of the Thirty Years War, Bavaria was swept by a plague epidemic. The local elders of Oberammergau vowed that if the villagers were spared, they would keep the events of the Passion every 10 years. The epidemic halted and in 1634 the villagers fulfilled their promise. Ever since, they have loyally kept their vow and in 2020 Oberammergau will, for the 42nd time, be staging the Passion Play. We are planning a trip, departing 2nd July: this is not a "Pilgrimage" as such, but a fully escorted 5-day tour to the castles and lakes of Bavaria finishing in Oberammergau for the Passion Play. The basic cost is £979 – places are already going very quickly and commitment has to be made by the beginning of December. 


