COUGHTON COURT: Monday 30th July

We are planning a day visit to Coughton Court: an imposing Tudor house in Warwickshire, set in beautiful gardens. The Coughton estate has been owned by the Throckmorton family since 1409, the name becoming notorious due to their opposition to the crown during the Reformation. Consequently, later rebuilding was restricted, so much of the house still stands largely as it was left. As practicing Catholics, the family provided refuge for Mass with a priest hole. The Hall also holds a place in English history for its roles in both the Throckmorton Plot of 1583 and the Gunpowder Plot of 1605. Since the Reformation, the Throckmorton family have remained staunchly Catholic and the Church of St Peter, St Paul and St Elizabeth, commissioned by Sir Robert Throckmorton, erected in 1857, provides weekly Mass for the local area.

This will be a private visit, including the celebration of Mass, a tour of the house with Magnus Throckmorton, and a tour of the gardens with the Head Gardener. As the estate will not be open to the public, the restaurant will be closed, but you can take your own refreshments. We will be able to have a meal later at one of the local pubs before returning.

We will leave from church at 9.00am and plan to depart from Coughton at around 5.00pm. The cost, covering the coach and entrance fee will be £38. If you are interested, please see Theresa after Mass and sign the list. Any queries please phone her on 01296 688839 or email t.short705@btinternet.com

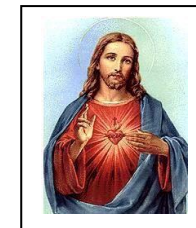
