Following the Synod discussion meetings held earlier in the year, a **Parish report**, collating these discussions was produced and sent to the Diocese. The Diocesan Synod Team distilled the various parish reports into a single **Diocesan report**, which was sent to the National Synod Team, who likewise, distilled all the different Diocesan reports into a single **National Synod Document**. This report has been sent to the *Conference of Bishops of England and Wales*, who have now published their **Reflection on the National Synod Document**. The National document and Bishops' reflection will be sent forward to the European team for onward transmission to Rome.

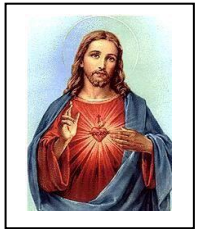
