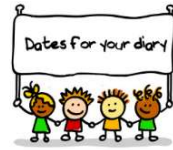


FUTURE EVENTS: Dates to save

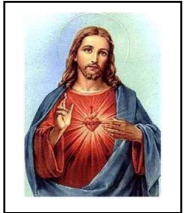
